12/20/2011	<p>Thank you for your kind advance on the Redistricting Map for the State Legislative Districts http://www.redistricting.wa.gov/assets/maps/121611_drafts/L-CG_3-0BigMapInsets.pdf. Upon review I have a suggestion. Previously, I was in the 44th. Now, I'm in the 21st. Your new map puts me in the 32nd. Now, it doesn't matter much which district I'm in. What does matter though is that with your new map has both the 32nd and the 1st split between King and Snohomish County. As a long time PCO I have seen the little bit of the 32nd that bulged into Snohomish County was hardly recognized at all and got no true representation at the county level. Kind of sad. Like the Kiskaddon Pimple of old. I would rather see that portion of the 1st in your map that is in King County shifted over to the 46th, the 1st shifted over to Lynnwood/MTL, and the 32nd shifted over to parts of the 46th on your map. I would like the 1st be wholly in Snohomish County still, and, as before, only the smallest portion of the 32nd that is required to be in Snohomish County be in as is now. Sure, those people in the Snohomish part of the 32nd would get poorer representation at the county level still but they are used to it. You may think that if a larger portion of two districts is split between counties both would suffer equally and have a voice in both counties politics. But a smaller representation of both districts in both counties insures that they would have effectivly no voice at all in both counties. If my change is adopted, the 1st District would have a full voice in Snohomish County and the 32nd would have nearly a full voice in King County as they have now.
