Chairman Lura Powell,

For the last 10 years I have served as the Statician for the Spokane Republican Party. I lived in Medical Lake, which is in the 9th Leg District. With the 8th, 13th, and 16th Districts having surplus this time, there will be pressure to remove the 9th from Spokane County.

I have attach a sample of the Data that I have given to the Spokane Republican Party. The numbers

are base on at least 6 races. The Average, black means Republicans advantage, red means Democrats advantage. the Swing vote is the Max Republican Vote - the Mini Republican Vote. The Percentage of Swing Vote is the Swing Vote divided by the Votes Casted. The Victory Levels is the amount of Swing Vote needed for a Republican victory in that District and County.

I have in the past try to share some of my files with the Spokane County Democrats Party. Only to get no Reply back, in last November of 2010 I again offer the Democrats at the Canvass report meeting my files, only to be told by there leading observer, "totally not interested in anything you have to show or say."

I do remember Dean Foster from 2001, he possibly does not remember me. In June of 2001 at the Public Works Building in Spokane I stated the KISS rule for Redistricting. Later at the Spokane Falls Community College, I was the only one to do a 2000 President Election Result base on each Redistricting Commissioner map.
