Hello,

I have a few questions regarding the redistricting, particularly with legislative districts.

Currently, Yakima County is divided into 3 legislative districts. A small slice of upper Yakima County belongs to the 13th District, while Yakima, Selah and Union Gap make up the 14th District. The rest of the the lower Yakima County from Moxee to Grandview belongs to the 15th District. How can that change, when taking into account the possiblity of a legislative district in the Yakima County being redrawn to have a majority Hispanic electorate(or population in general)? Where will that district be redrawn? What cities will likely fall into that district?

Another city with an increasing Hispanic population is Pasco. Currently, Pasco is part of the 16th District which includes Walla Walla, Dayton, and other small towns and cities. According to the Malapportionment Report, Pasco gained 34,542 in population. How will this affect the redistricting? Is it possible that a disrict will be redrawn in the Pasco area? Will Walla Walla be cut out of the district?

I would appreciate if you could provide me with hypothetical maps of district redrawings in the counties of Yakima and Franklin.
