It was mentioned that citizens could submit redistricting proposals to the commission. I would like to suggest that the redistricting commission make all proposals submitted available to the public for comment before adopting a final plan. Maybe you were already planning to do this. But sometimes different people might have different ideas that are good. One person might prepare a plan that makes sense in some areas, while someone else might have a different idea that makes more sense in another area. Getting comments about specific plans before adopting any of them may provide a valuable opportunity to fine-tune things. So I would like to urge not only getting general input before discussing specific plans, but getting input on specific plans.
