Recommendation: As a Shoreline resident, I believe that the City of Shoreline is most similar to other North King County cities: Lake Forest Park, Kenmore, Bothell, and even Woodinville. These cities share many similar characteristics as part of King County; including a shared transit corridor in SR 522, jobs in Seattle, and a suburban lifestyle and mentality. On a regular basis, the Mayors of these cities meet and discuss issues of regional concern. When Kenmore's City Hall was dedicated in 2010, elected officials from each of the cities were in attendance. Together, these cities constitute nearly an entire LD, and likely an entire LD if you were to include the Bothell annexation areas.

I believe that cities, especially suburban cities should remain intact. However, if Shoreline is to be broken up, either in an LD or CD, I would encourage the commission to divide the city based on the existing neighborhoods within the City. The current dividing line between the 1st CD and 7th CD does not show any respect for these neighborhood lines.
