I am a native to Port Orchard, WA and live in the McCormick Woods community which was recently annexed to Port Orchard. While Port Orchard is in the 26th Legislative District, McCormick Woods is in the 35th District. Our community interests and concerns are aligned with the 26th district, not Mason, Grays Harbor, and Thurston Counties. Our travel from the Kitsap Peninsula is over the Tacoma Narrows Bridge or by ferry--not through Mason County.

As boundaries are redefined for the congressional districts, is there any way that McCormick Woods can be moved back into the 26th Legislative District? I hope realignment will occur to better serve our area. With the annexation of McCormick Woods to Port Orchard, I believe we should also be realigned legislatively. My family and I do all of our business in the 26th district, so we feel we should have representation from legislators elected to serve the 26th District.
