


Using the raw district census data for the two legislative plans (thank you, Nick Pharris), I calculated the "non-compactness" of the two plans. It was pretty hard with 195,000 records per file - the data software that I use is limited to 65,000 records. Here's the results:





As before, my lack of compactness measure is the total population on the "wrong" side of the black lines halfway between adjacent districts' population centers (labelled black circles). Gorton-Huff's plan is a little more compact than Ceis-Foster's, maybe due to the big differences between districts 14 and 16.
