Here's a list of blocks, with a total population of nine persons, as to which I very much doubt that they are in the districts which you intended. Largely, though not entirely, they represent blocks which lie between a district boundary and a county or municipal boundary. Thus, in most cases they represent the kind of "orphan" situations which the county auditors would prefer that you not create.

I don't represent that this is complete. These were problems I happened across as I was evaluating something else. So there may be problems elsewhere which I haven't happened to encounter yet.

In addition, there were some situations which I excluded on the grounds that the blocks were populated and may have been placed as they were with regard to district boundaries for population reasons.
