The congressional plan proposed on December 28 contains, in Skagit county, several small population areas caught between a municipal boundary and a district boundary. Depending on the practices of the Skagit county auditor this may cause either discontinuous precincts or orphan precincts. By shifting the boundary between districts 1 and 2 in Skagit county, the district boundary can more fully follow municipal and school district boundaries and avoid the precincting issues the current proposal may produce.
