What Part of Pierce County is included in the Proposed District?

Generally speaking, the proposed district is east of SR 161 and south of Lawrence Creek, SR 162, Spiketon Ditch and the southern boundary of Buckley. Municipalities within this area are Orting, Eatonville, South Prairie, Carbonado and Wilkeson. Buckley and Enumclaw are not in it.

Detailed Boundary Description in Pierce County

From Lewis County, north on SR 7, east on Eatonville Highway, north on the western boundary of Eatonville, north on SR 161, east on 200th St E (Howe Rd), north on 107th Ave Ct E, west on 195th St Ct E, north on 106th Ave Ct E, west on 194th St E, north on SR 161, east on 187th St E, MISSING SOMETHING HERE, north on Lipoma Firs E, east on 183rd St E, east on a tributary of Lawrence Creek, east on Lawrence Creek, east on Puyallup River, north on western boundary of Orting, south on eastern boundary of Orting, south on SR 162, east on SR 165, east on Spiketon Ditch, east on southern boundary of Buckley to King County.

AND

From King County, south on boundary of Enumclaw to King County.




