





Description of Proposed Districts

The proposed Federal Way district is composed of the cities of Federal Way and Des Moines and the unincorporated area east of Federal Way, generally south of S 293rd Street.

The proposed Auburn district is composed of the cities of Auburn, Algona, Pacific, Sumner and Bonney Lake and unincorporated areas in all directions from Bonney Lake, including the Lake Tapps area.

The proposed Puyallup district is composed of the cities of Puyallup, Edgewood, Fife and Milton, and that part of the city of Tacoma east of the Puyallup River. It also includes unincorporated areas, including Dash Point, Browns Point, Fife Heights, Waller, and Summit CDPs and most of North Puyallup, Midland, Clover Creek and Summit View CDPs, and parts of Parkland and South Hill CDPs. The western boundary of the district in Midland CDP is F Street and Aqueduct Drive. The western boundary in Parkland CDP is Aqueduct Drive and Golden Given Road. In general, the southern boundary in Parkland, Clover Creek and Summitview CDPs is 144th Street. The area of South Hill CDP within the proposed Puyallup district is the area north of a boundary composed of 144th Street, 94th Avenue, 136th Street, Meridian Avenue, 128th Street, 111th Avenue, and, in general, 122nd Street. North Puyallup CDP is divided, in general, along the alignment of the western border of Sumner.

The proposed Orting district contains only one municipality, Orting. It also includes the McMillin, Graham, Frederickson, and Elk Plain CDPs, and the parts of South Hill, Summit View and Clover Creek CDPs not included in the proposed Puyallup district. It also includes that part of Parkland CDP south of 144th Street and east of Pacific Avenue and that part of Spanaway CDP east of a boundary comprised of Pacific Avenue, 166th Street and, generally, Park Avenue. It also includes an unincorporated area between Orting and Graham west of the Puyallup river and an unincorporated area between Crocker CDP and Bonney Lake.

The proposed Lakewood district includes the cities of Lakewood, Steilacoom and DuPont and that part of Tacoma south of 84th and generally west of Park. It also includes Joint Base Lewis-McChord and Ketrion, Anderson and McNeil Islands. And it includes most of Parkland CDP (parts not included in the Puyallup and Orting districts) and that part of Spanaway CDP not included in the Orting district.

The city of Tacoma is proposed to be divided among four districts as it is currently. The area east of the Puyallup river is in the proposed Puyallup district, the area south of 84th and generally west of Park is in the proposed Lakewood district. The rest of the city is in the proposed Tacoma Central district, except the portion west of a boundary composed of Stevens Street 19th Street and Orchard Street, which is part of the proposed Tacoma West district. The proposed Tacoma Central district is entirely within the city of Tacoma. The proposed Tacoma West district also includes the cities of University Place and Fircrest and the town of Ruston and the Gig Harbor and Key Peninsulas and Fox Island.
