

Commissioner Slade Gorton stated that he and Commissioner Tim Ceis have been working on the area between the Sound and the mountains north of King County, and have moved into King County. He said they have made substantial progress but aren't there yet. Commissioner Ceis agreed with Commissioner Gorton and stated that they hoped to provide more details at the Commission's November 29 meeting.

Chair Powell asked if there was a need to assign more districts at this time. Commissioners Huff, Gorton, and Foster said they did not need any further assignments at this time. Commissioner Huff stated that Commissioners Ceis and Gorton would continue to work on legislative districts 5, 11, 41, 45, 47, and 48 and he and Commissioner Foster would work on legislative districts 2, 25, 27, 28, 29, and 31. Commissioner Foster agreed.
